Brief Précis: The research study examines the complexity of black female experience in white America, depicted in Toni Morrison’s fictional narratives. It attempts to resolve the contradiction, inherent in the African American identity. Morrison’s literary work explores the deeper meaning of what it means to be black in white America. The Eurocentric culture of white American paralyses the idea of selfhood for African American men and women. The study attempts to problematize the double marginalization of racial discrimination and gender bias. It presents how being black , the women suffered from racism and being female, they were the victims of the white as well as the black males.

Topic: “Voicing for the Voiceless and Voicing of the Voiceless: The Problematic of Representation of Dalits in Select Literary Narratives”

Brief Précis: The problematic of representation of voiceless Depressed Classes, who are also known as Dalits, is critically viewed in this study with reference to the select fictional texts by non-Dalits about the oppressed and the auto-narratives by Dalit writers, to understand the underlying politics of representation and casteist forces, which legitimize the marginality of Dalits in the hegemonic Hindu society. The depiction and documentation of Dalits’ realities in the texts of non-Dalit and Dalit writers has been studied within the rubric of select literary standards, such as the authenticity of Dalit experience, Dalit consciousness and the legitimacy for literary representation of Dalit life and living. This study has centred around the eight representative literary texts of non-Dalit writers such as Mulk Raj Anand’s novel, *Untouchable* (1935), Gopinath Mohanty’s *Paraja* (*Paraja* in Oriya and translated into English by Bikram. K. Das in 1987), U.R. Anantamurthy’s *Samskara : A Rite for a Dead Man* (*Samskara* in Kannada and translated into English by A.K.Ramanujan in 1976), Arundathi Roys’s *The God of Small Things* (1997), and the Dalit writers’ auto-narratives, like Sharan Kumar Limbale’s *The Outcaste* (*Akkarmashi* in Marathi and translated into English by Santosh Bhoomkar in 2003), Kishore Shantabai Kale’s *Against All Odds* (*Kolbatyacha Por* in Marathi and translated into English by Sandhya Pandey in 2000), Om Prakash Valmiki’s *Joothan: A Dalit’s Life* (*Joothan* in Hindi & translated into English by Arun Prabha Mukherjee in 2003), Y. B. Satyanarayana’s *My Father Baliab* (2011).
