	year's (2022) theme was "Transformative solutions for inclusive
	development: the role of innovation in fuelling an accessible and
	equitable world". The event started with an introduction where the
	audience was asked to guess what was being said using sign language.
	The audience, the principal, and the teachers were welcomed with a
	welcome speech. Then there was a poem recitation; the poem was based
	on the struggles faced by disabled people, and how they are looked upon
	in society, even with all their struggles they didn't lose hope and still
	have dreams and aspirations. The 4 <sup>th</sup> segment of the event was an
	informative presentation; there are at present 2.86 CR disabled people out
	of which 1.50 CR are males and 1.18 CR are females. Rights of Persons
	with Disabilities 2016 includes rights for people with Blindness,
	Low-vision, Leprosy Cured persons, Hearing Impairment (deaf and hard
	of hearing), Locomotor Disability, Dwarfism, Intellectual Disability,
	Mental Illness, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Cerebral Palsy, Muscular

Dystrophy, Chronic Neurological conditions, Specific Learning Disabilities, Multiple Sclerosis, Speech and Language disability, Thalassemia, Hemophilia, Sickle Cell Disease, Multiple Disabilities including deaf-blindness, Acid Attack victims, Parkinson's disease. The 5<sup>th</sup> segment of the event was two games Barriers begone and Fact or Myth. Barriers begone game provided solutions to the problems faced by disabled people. Fact or Myth game tried to burst myths around disability. The 6<sup>th</sup> and last segment was "Udaa Phir Bhi Mai Udaa" which is an inspirational song that encourages disabled people that whatever might be the problems they face due to their disability they should always be hopeful and fulfill their dreams. The event concluded with a Vote of Thanks to the audience.














Expected Outcome	In today's time, it is very important that people are aware of the different types of disabilities that exist, the challenges they face and what can be the solutions to the problems.
