



WDC utilizes offline as well online platforms effectively for campaigns and programmes on gender amity, women's welfare and to recognize individual efforts towards equality and empowerment.

Following are some of the efforts undertaken by WDC in past one year towards creating awareness:

1. Super Woman of The Week campaign:

This campaign celebrates women who have achieved extraordinary feats in their respective fields. This is a weekly campaign which WDC runs across all major social media platforms like Instagram, Facebook and Twitter for better reach. US Vice President Kamala Harris, France's National Order of Merit awardee Rohini Godole and Alliance Air CEO Harpreet A De Singh are some of the popular faces that WDC featured in the campaign.

2. Kalamkaar:

Annual theme based content writing competition Kalamkaar was held in the 3rd week of November, 2020. The central theme for the content writing was given as Diwali. But that's not all! Participants had to choose one from five key words namely - Safety, Equality, Go Green, Vocal for Local and Mother and pair it up with the central theme of Diwali and come up with their write-ups. The competition was a success with students registering from more that 40+ institutes all across India.



3. Manasvini 2021:

This is the week long annual flagship event of WDC which is held in the 2nd week of March starting from International Women's Day i.e. 8th March. This year, WDC organized numerous events engaging a significant audience involving alums, faculties and students. Theme for Manasvini was in line with the International Women's Day 2021 campaign - "Choose To Challenge". Manasvini 2021 saw a total of 4 events details of which are as follows:

1. A **Guest Lecture** held on 8th March, 2021 which saw the students blown away by the discussion on the topic "Women Empowerment and Challenging Gender Bias".

The speakers were: Sushmeetha Bubna, Founder and CEO at Voice Vision and Faiyda, helping and uplifting the specially-abled through social entrepreneurship and training and Anupriya Chowdhary, an alumna of K J Somaiya Institute of Management (Batch of 2009) and the Founder of WonderSkills India, enriching lives as a Career Coach, Soft Skills Trainer, Author and Blogger.

2.AdVision 2021 - A theme-based case study competition that went live on 8th March, 2021 and was held exclusively for the students of K J Somaiya Institute of Management which saw some brilliant minds come together and provide innovative ideas and solutions to the topic "Household Product Innovation for Women".

The topic was revealed to the 7 teams 24 hours prior to the event and the competition was held live on 10th March, 2021.

- **3. Digital Poster Making Competition** The competition went live on 7th March, 2021 with the theme "Woman Who Inspires Me". Several students from across 20+ institutes registered for the competition. The deadline for submissions was 12th March, 2021. The first position was bagged by Kanika Gopal from Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women (IGDTUW) while Sharmishtha Dash from Symbiosis Institute of Business Management, Bangalore was declared the runner-up.
- **4. Seed Stars** 2021 The final day was concluded by 6 of our fellow batchmates, who are budding entrepreneurs, sharing some interesting anecdotes about the problems they faced, the pressure they endured, the success they achieved and their plans for the future regarding their respective entrepreneurial ventures. The event acted as a platform for them to interact with the other students and give them a glimpse into the mind of an entrepreneur.




